FPED VI is sponsored by the Joint Staff, Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition, Technology, and Logistics (OUSD AT&L), the Department of Energy, the National Institute of Justice, and the Technical Support Working Group. The US Army Product Manager, Force Protection Systems (PM-FPS), Fort Belvoir, Virginia, is coordinating the demonstration of current state-of-the-art commercial-off-the-shelf components and systems to Department of Defense, Federal agency, and state and local law enforcement and corrections agency decision makers responsible for physical security/force protection (PS/FP). FPED VI is a unique opportunity to see the latest in technology and innovations in force protection equipment from industry.

The demonstrations will run from 10:00 AM to 4:30 PM daily with range demonstrations of blast and ballistics mitigation equipment and night vision equipment. FPED VI is expected to attract 600 vendors demonstrating over 3,000 items of PS/FP equipment. The demonstration is unclassified but is NOT open to the public. It is intended for DoD, Federal departments and agencies, and state and local law enforcement and corrections agencies.
